Avipro Avian can also be sprinkled on food at 1 pinch (approx 0.1 g) per kg of animal.

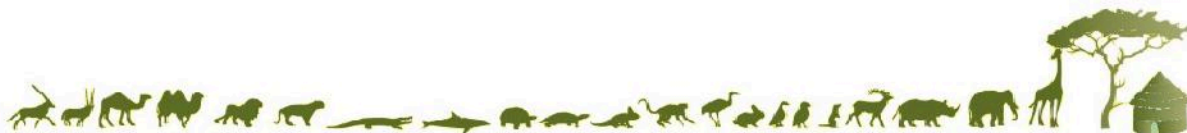
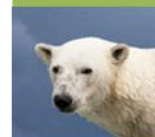

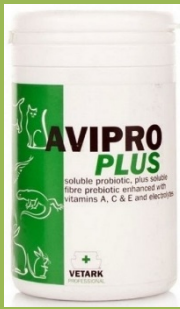
